The use of local products to highlight Jamaica's gastronomy with a sustainable approach is the focus of my approach and has impacted gastronomic tourism locally and highlighted our potential in the global market.

The American Culinary Federation (ACF) Jamaica Chapter, established in 2019, with the aim to educate, train and certify, has ushered in approximately 200 members and continues to build on the culinary development of the industry. Together with the Jamaica Centre of Tourism Innovation (JCTI), the ACF has delivered free online courses and certification to culinary professionals furloughed during the Covid-19 pandemic. Since 2021, many of these candidates have gradually gone back to work with expanded knowledge and advanced qualification, acquiring higher positions and better remuneration.

IGCAT's World Region of Gastronomy initiative is a resource powerhouse of knowledge, experience and networking that undoubtedly can propel Jamaica's gastronomy. In addition, our team of IGCAT experts can provide valuable guidance to the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries (MOAF) and the Ministry of Health and Wellness (MOHW) through its networking platform towards greater sustainability and collaboration, employing chefs as agents of change.
